Housing Support

Elders referred to the EMOT program who are homeless or at risk of homelessness have the support of additional services provided by our Housing Coordinator through a grant funded by Bristol Elder Services. The Housing Coordinator will assess the current situation and provide support to the elder to mediate landlord issues, as well as to access other resources for shelter or new housing.
