PROGRAMS OFFERED



In order to meet the varying needs of clients, we offer both a Day Treatment and a Partial Hospitalization Program.

Day Treatment

Day Treatment is a therapeutic program that promotes the development of skills to manage symptoms and improve quality of life.

Partial Hospitalization (PHP)

Partial Hospitalization provides intensive, structured, comprehensive therapy for the individual who would benefit from skilled outpatient intervention in lieu of inpatient treatment. In addition, clients meet weekly with the staff psychiatrist for medication management.

Multidisciplinary Team

A team of experienced clinicians closely monitor each client's mental status, to provide individualized treatment planning. Each client is assigned a treatment coordinator who works with the client to effectively utilize the programs' services. The treatment coordinator also acts as a liaison to other care providers.
